AMENDMENT No. 1 TO FRANCHISE AGREEMENT FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING SERVICES

This Amendment No. 1 to Franchise Agreement (this "Amendment") is entered into as of July 1, 2022 between the City of Vallejo, a charter city and municipal corporation ("CITY"), and Recology Vallejo, a California corporation ("CONTRACTOR").

WHEREAS, CITY and CONTRACTOR are parties to that certain Franchise Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal and Recycling Services dated October 1, 2016 (the "Franchise Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Franchise Agreement as set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Effective Date. This Amendment No. 1 shall take effect as of July 1, 2022.
- 2. <u>Term</u>. Sections 2.01, 2.02 and 2.03 of the Franchise Agreement are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:

"2.01 <u>Term</u>. The term of this Agreement shall be for a fifteen- (15-) year period beginning October 1, 2016 and terminating on September 30, 2031.

2.02 <u>Ten- (10-) Year Extension</u>. CONTRACTOR may request one ten- (10-) year term extension to the original fifteen- (15-) year term, and at CITY's sole option, CITY may grant CONTRACTOR's request to extend the term. Under no circumstances will CITY be obligated to extend the term. CONTRACTOR must request the ten- (10-) year extension by March 31, 2029 in order to be eligible for the term extension. If CONTRACTOR is found to have a Specified Default (as described in Section 24.09), CONTRACTOR will not be eligible for the ten- (10-) year extension.

2.03 <u>Performance Review prior to Ten- (10-) Year Extension</u>. If CONTRACTOR requests a term extension as described in Section 2.02 above, then, at CITY's sole option, a billing audit and performance review shall, prior to December 31, 2029, be conducted as described in Article 20, and CONTRACTOR must pay the cost of the billing audit and performance review subject to the maximum cost specified in such Article. Regardless of the outcome of this billing audit and performance review, CITY will have no obligation to extend the term of the Agreement."

- 3. Adjustments in the Use of the Consumer Price Index.
 - (a) Article 1, Definitions, is hereby amended to add the following definition:

"<u>WST</u>. The Consumer Price Index, All Urban Consumers, Water and Sewer and Trash Collection Services, U.S. City Average, Seasonally Adjusted, Series ID: CUSR0000SEHG, published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics."

(b) All references in the Franchise Agreement to "CPI" are hereby amended to be references to "WST," except in Sections 1.34 and 4.02.1.1.

(c) Section 4.02.1.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"4.02.1.1 Initial Adjustments. For the Maximum Service Rates effective January 1, 2018, rates shall be adjusted using one-hundred percent (100%) of the twelve (12) month average percentage change in CPI, calculated as the percentage difference between average CPI value for the period of July 2016 through June 2017 (the previous year) and the average CPI value for the period July 2015 through June 2016 (the prior previous year). For the Maximum Service Rates effective January 1, 2019, January 1, 2020, January 1, 2021, and January 1, 2022, rates shall be adjusted using one-hundred percent (100%) of the twelve (12) month average percentage change in CPI, calculated as the percentage difference between the average CPI value for the previous year (July through June) and the average CPI value for the prior previous year (July through June). Contractor shall apply the percentage change to the Maximum Service Rates as listed in Exhibit 1 as attached to this Agreement and submit CONTRACTOR's request for an adjustment to the Maximum Service Rates to CITY in the same form as Exhibit 1, for confirmation by CITY that CONTRACTOR's calculations are correct. The request for an adjustment to the Maximum Service Rates shall be submitted to CITY by September 1 of each year. If the request is not submitted to CITY by September 1 CONTRACTOR will be deemed to have waived its right to a rate adjustment for that year."

- (d) Section 4.02.1.2 is hereby amended to replace the year "2019" with the year "2023."
- (e) Section 4.02.1.4 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"4.02.1.4 The actual annual WST rate adjustment percentage may not exceed five percent (5.00%) or be less than one percent (1.00%) in any year. If in any year the calculated rate adjustment exceeds five percent (5.00%) or is less than one percent (below 1.00%), the excess or shortfall amounts will not be added to or subtracted from the rate adjustment percentage in any following year."

4. <u>Contamination</u>. Section 3.13 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"3.13 Contamination. CONTRACTOR shall only be required to collect Recyclable Materials if they have been separated by the Service Recipient from Garbage and Organic Waste and shall only be required to collect Organic Waste if it has been separated by the Service Recipient from Garbage and Recyclable Materials. If by visual inspection of a container it appears that Recyclable Materials are contaminated with ten percent (10%) or more by weight or volume of Garbage or Organic Waste, or Organic Waste is contaminated with five percent (5%) or more by weight or volume of Garbage or Recyclables, then CONTRACTOR will leave the container unemptied along with a Non-collection Notice which contains instructions on the proper procedures for setting out Recyclable Materials or Organic Waste. The notice shall also inform the Service Recipient of the following options for dealing with the contaminated container, which the Service Recipient may exercise by calling CONTRACTOR'S customer service line. The Service Recipient may:

(i) Leave the contents of the container as is, and call CONTRACTOR's customer service department to request that CONTRACTOR collect the container

as Garbage on the Service Recipient's next regularly scheduled collection day. In this case, the container will be collected as Garbage, and the Service Recipient will be charged the then-applicable rate for Garbage "extras."

(ii) Leave the contents of the container as is, and have CONTRACTOR make a special pick-up of the container on a day other than the Service Recipient's next regularly scheduled collection day. In this case, the container will be collected as Garbage, and the Service Recipient will be charged the then-applicable rate for a special collection of Garbage,

(iii) Remove the excess contamination from the container (so that remaining contamination is less than the thresholds indicated above), and have CONTRACTOR collect the container as Recyclable Materials or Organic Waste on the Service Recipient's next regularly scheduled collection day, at no additional charge. If on the next regularly scheduled collection day the contamination level has not been reduced below the thresholds indicated above, then CONTRACTOR may refuse to collect the container, and leave a notice as provided in the first paragraph of this Section 3.13 (i.e., the above process will begin anew)."

5. <u>Garbage Overages</u>. Section 7.04.3 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"7.04.3 <u>Garbage Overages</u>. CONTRACTOR shall collect Garbage Overages placed in 32-gallon plastic bags (or other bags or bundles deemed acceptable by CONTRACTOR) set out beside Garbage Carts or Bins by SFD, MFD or Commercial Service Recipients on the Service Recipient's regularly scheduled collection day, provided, however, that CONTRACTOR shall not be required to collect more than 32 gallons of overages unless the Service Recipient has scheduled such collection with CONTRACTOR in advance. CONTRACTOR may charge for Garbage Overages at the rates as set forth in Exhibit 1. For the avoidance of doubt, this Section 7.04.3 is intended to include and additionally apply to MFD and Commercial Service Recipients, even though Section 7.04 generally focuses on SFD Service Recipients."

6. <u>AB 939 Support Fee</u>. Section 4.03.2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"CONTRACTOR shall pay an AB 399 Support Fee to CITY for CITY'S costs to provide AB 939 Support Services. Such fee shall initially be **Three Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$340,000)** each Agreement Year. The total annual payment amount to CITY shall be divided into quarterly payments due on January 31st, April 30th, July 31st, and October 31st of each Agreement Year, with the first payment occurring on October 31, 2016. The total annual amount of this fee will be adjusted each January 31 by changes in CPI, calculated as set forth in Section 4.02.1. In addition, effective January 1, 2023, the total annual amount of the AB 939 Support Fee shall be increased one time by Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000) in addition to the WST adjustment applicable on that date."

7. <u>Diversion</u>. Section 5.01 is hereby amended to add a new Section 5.01.6, to read in its entirety as follows:

"5.01.6 The parties acknowledge that the level of diversion achieved by CONTRACTOR depends on various factors beyond CONTRACTOR's control, such as the characteristics of the waste stream, growth or contraction of the local economy, the degree of source separation by generators, and independent diversion activities by generators (e.g., backhauling of organics or sale of

recyclables). Accordingly, notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be deemed for all purposes under this Agreement to have met its diversion requirement under Section 5.01 for a given calendar year (and the remedies available to CITY under Sections 5.01.3, 5.09, 5.11 and 19.03(w) shall not be exercised with respect to such year) if during such year CONTRACTOR fully implements all diversion programs required by this Agreement. Such programs consist of the Diversion and Public Education Plan set forth in Exhibit 4, the SB 1383-Related Services set forth in Exhibit 9, and delivery of source-separated Recyclable Materials and Organic Waste to appropriate facilities for processing."

8. <u>Default Garbage Cart Size</u>. Section 7.01.1 is hereby amended to add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph:

"When a new SFD Service Recipient calls to initiate service and does not request a specific Garbage Cart size, CONTRACTOR shall offer the Service Recipient a 64-gallon Garbage Cart, it being understood that the Service Recipient may choose a different-size Garbage Cart."

9. <u>SFD Organics</u>. The first paragraph of Section 7.07 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"7.07 <u>SFD Organic Waste Collection Service</u>. This service, which includes Green Waste only, is to begin on October 1, 2016. Effective July 1, 2022, this service shall include commingled Green Waste and Food Waste. This service will be governed by the following terms and conditions:"

10. <u>SFD Bulky Waste</u>. Section 7.11.1 is hereby amended to add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph:

"Effective January 1, 2023, and subject to Section 7.18, the number of free Bulky Waste Collections that each SFD Services Unit is entitled to receive in each Agreement Year shall increase from two (2) to four (4)."

11. <u>SFD Dumping</u>. Article 7 is hereby amended to add a new Section 7.17, to read in its entirety as follows:

"7.17 Free SFD Dumping at Devlin Road. Subject to Section 7.18, and the agreement of the Devlin Road Transfer Station, CONTRACTOR shall annually distribute free dump passes to SFD Service Recipients entitling each household to dump one (1) load of acceptable material at the Transfer Station during a calendar year, at no additional charge to the Service Recipient, provided the load does not exceed 1,000 lbs. CONTRACTOR shall arrange with the Transfer Station to pay for material delivered in accordance with the dump pass. The first distribution of dump passes shall be for calendar year 2023. Unless otherwise agreed by CONTRACTOR, acceptable material shall be limited to material that the Transfer Station will accept at no charge beyond the standard fee for MSW. CONTRACTOR shall distribute the coupons by mail by January 31 each year. Passes shall be distributed to SFDs through standard U.S. mail. Annually, CONTRACTOR shall invoice CITY for reimbursement of CONTRACTOR's payments to the Devlin Road Transfer Station for disposal of acceptable material in the previous calendar year and provide supporting documentation. CITY shall pay such invoices within 30 days."

12. <u>Maximum Cost of New SFD Services</u>. Article 7 is hereby amended to add a new Section 7.18, to read in its entirety as follows:

"7.18 <u>Maximum Cost of Additional SFD Services</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall only be required to provide (i) disposal of Bulky Waste, (ii) the free SFD dumping provided for in Section 7.17, and (iii) free dumping by CITY at the Devlin Road Transfer Station, to the extent the combined disposal cost of those three (3) items does not exceed \$267,000 in any Agreement Year. Such maximum cost shall be adjusted effective January 1, 2024 and each January 1 thereafter by the percent change in WST, calculated as set forth in Section 4.02.1. To the extent the costs of these programs exceed such maximum cost, CITY shall reimburse CONTRACTOR for its reasonable costs of providing such programs. Annually, CONTRACTOR shall invoice CITY for such costs in the previous calendar year and provide supporting documentation. CITY shall pay such invoices within 30 days. If CITY fails to do so, then CONTRACTOR may cease or reduce such programs. Before doing so, CONTRACTOR shall give at least thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Customers (if they are affected) and City."

<u>Bundled Organics Service</u>. Section 9.04.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"9.04.1 Conditions of Service. CONTRACTOR shall provide Commercial Organic Waste Collection Service to all Commercial Service Units in the Service Area whose Organic Waste materials are properly containerized in Organic Waste Bins, Carts, Debris Boxes, or Compactors except as set forth below, where the Organic Waste Bins, Carts, debris Boxes, or Compactors are accessible. As part of the charge for Garbage collection, CONTRACTOR shall provide, to each Commercial Service Unit subscribed for recurring collection of Garbage from CONTRACTOR, one 64-gallon Organic Waste Cart for each Garbage container of any size so subscribed and shall service such Organic Waste Cart(s) weekly, unless in each case the customer refuses to accept the Cart(s) or service, or the customer is not required by law to have Organics service waiver. Initially, CONTRACTOR shall offer one 64-gallon Organic Waste Cart to each Commercial Service Unit that is subscribed for Garbage collection but has no Organic Waste container and shall notify the Service Unit that additional Carts may be available at no additional charge beyond the charge for Garbage collection. If a Service Unit requests more 64-gallon Organic Waste Cart(s) than the number provided at no additional charge, or requests service from any type of container other than a 64-gallon Cart, or requests more frequent collection, then CONTRACTOR may charge for such services at the rate set forth in Exhibit 1. CONTRACTOR agrees that not all Commercial and MFD Service Units will elect to receive Organic Waste Collection Service in Carts, and that CONTRACTOR will provide Organic Waste Collection Bins upon request and as necessary. Further, CONTRACTOR agrees that there are several Commercial Service Units that utilize Compactors for collection or Organic Waste, and that CONTRACTOR will provide a sufficient number of Carts or Bins and at a collection frequency to allow for any such Commercial Service Unit to utilize the collection of Organic Waste. Commercial Organic Waste Collection will occur Monday - Friday, and on Saturdays upon request and as necessary."

13. <u>Blight Reduction Services</u>. Section 10.01.4 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"10.01.4 <u>Blight Reduction Services</u>. CONTRACTOR shall provide collection of blight causing materials within CITY as provided in this section.

10.1.4.1 CITY shall collect information regarding the type, quantity and locations of blight causing materials from the observations of its own personnel and/or reports by members of the public submitted to CITY via CITY's website, email address and/or phone number for that purpose. CONTRACTOR shall not be responsible for accepting reports of blight causing materials from the public, and instead shall refer the person to the appropriate CITY channels.

10.1.4.2 CITY may from time-to-time request CONTRACTOR to collect and properly dispose of blight causing materials from within the city limits of CITY. Such requests shall be submitted to CONTRACTOR in a manner to be mutually agreed between CITY and CONTRACTOR. Upon receipt of such a request, CONTRACTOR shall collect the blight causing materials within two (2) business days, or one (1) business day if the material blocks a public right-of-way or poses a threat to public health. CONTRACTOR shall dispose of (or, if commercially reasonable, recycle) any blight causing materials so collected, in compliance with applicable laws.

10.1.4.3 CONTRACTOR shall only be required to collect Solid Waste that is on the public right of way or CITY property in a location easily accessible by CONTRACTOR's personnel and vehicles; that fits into CONTRACTOR's vehicle; that that can be readily loaded without sweeping or gathering; and that can be safely loaded into the vehicle by two (2) people without being carried more than twenty-five feet (25').

10.1.4.4 CONTRACTOR shall not be required to collect: Hazardous Waste, Sharps, Biohazardous or Biomedical Waste, or other Exempt Waste; liquid or semi-solid waste; loose litter, dirt, or other materials; material from homeless encampments or from any homeless person; or any material that may belong to a person. In addition, CONTRACTOR shall not be required to collect material on or along Interstate 80, Interstate 780, or Highway 37.

10.1.4.5 CONTRACTOR shall not be required to operate more than four (4) routes devoted to the collection services described in this Section 10.01.4, consisting of two (2) rear loaders and two (2) flatbed trucks, each staffed with one (1) driver, operating 8 hour per day Monday-Friday. It is understood that the volume of requests for blight pickup, compared to available resources, will affect the time it takes to respond to CITY's requests."

14. <u>City-Sponsored Events</u>. Section 10.02 is hereby amended to add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph:

"Service to any CITY-sponsored events [not listed on Exhibit 3] shall be subject to compliance with CONTRACTOR's conflict-of-interest policies and applicable laws."

- 15. <u>VCUSD</u>. Section 10.03.1 (School Recycling Program) is hereby deleted in its entirety, together with the related definition in Section 1.91.
- 16. Waste Zero Specialist. Section 14.02 (Waste Zero Specialist) is hereby amended to read in

its entirety as follows:

"CONTRACTOR will provide for a full-time Waste Zero Specialist dedicated to providing support for recycling and sustainability programs, including performing commercial waste audits and outreach and support to commercial and multi-family accounts. The Waste Zero Specialist job description is listed in **Exhibit 8**. The Waste Zero Specialist will meet with key CITY staff on a quarterly basis to review performance on diversion programs. CONTRACTOR may use subcontractors to perform some or all of the duties normally assigned to the Waste Zero Specialist. The Waste Zero Specialist will advise appropriate personnel within a business on methods and recommendations to increase recycling and decrease solid waste, the selection of collection services and container sizes to maximize diversion, and the potential cost savings if the business takes the recommended actions to increase diversion; educate and train staff and janitors on best practices for recycling, waste reduction and availability and use of in-house recycling containers; educate personnel on how to maximize diversion; and provide such personnel with educational materials, posters, labels, and memos.

17. <u>City-Selected Software</u>. Article 16 is hereby amended to add a new Section 16.04, to read in its entirety as follows:

"16.04 Software. On a quarterly basis beginning July 1, 2022, CONTRACTOR shall provide CITY with an Excel file that includes the name, address and service level of CONTRACTOR's customers within the CITY and CITY shall arrange for such file to be uploaded to a cloud-based software system selected by CITY, provided the following conditions are met: (a) the information is provided by CONTRACTOR in a single Excel file, (b) the software allows CONTRACTOR to readily access and download the information that CONTRACTOR has provided, (c) CITY pays for the cost of the licensing or contracting for use of the system by CONTRACTOR, including at least one (1) license for a CONTRACTOR user, (d) the software vendor is not owned or controlled by a competitor of Recology, and (e) the software vendor enters into an agreement with CONTRACTOR reasonably acceptable to CONTRACTOR that requires the vendor (and its affiliates, successors and any future acquiror) to: keep any CONTRACTOR-provided information confidential (except as to the CITY and CONTRACTOR); not use said information for any purpose other than monitoring, reporting and compliance purposes of the CITY and CONTRACTOR; maintain adequate data security; and indemnify CONTRACTOR to the same extent as it indemnifies CITY. In the event of any discrepancy that cannot be reconciled between information in CONTRACTOR's system and information in the CITYselected cloud-based software system, the information in CONTRACTOR's system shall govern, absent manifest error. The preceding sentence only applies to information regarding CONTRACTOR's services to customers."

18. <u>Performance Review</u>. Section 20.01.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"20.01.1 <u>Selection and Cost.</u> CITY may conduct billing, audit, and performance reviews ("reviews") of CONTRACTOR'S performance during the term of this Agreement with one (1) performance review to occur by December 31, 2023. The reviews will be performed by a qualified firm under contract to CITY. CITY shall have the final responsibility for the selection of the firm but may seek and accept comments and recommendations from CONTRACTOR. CITY may conduct unlimited billing, audit, and performance reviews at any time during the Agreement, but CONTRACTOR shall only be obligated to pay the cost of the billing

audit and performance review described in Section 2.03, if such a review is conducted at CITY's sole option after CONTRACTOR has requested a term extension. For that review, CONTRACTOR will be responsible for a maximum cost of One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000)."

- 19. <u>SB 1383-Related Services</u>. The Franchise Agreement is hereby amended to add a new Exhibit 9 thereto, which Exhibit shall read as set forth in Exhibit 9 to this Amendment.
- 20. <u>Exhibits</u>. Exhibit 1 of the Franchise Agreement are hereby amended to read as set forth in Exhibit 1 to this Amendment. Such exhibit and Exhibit 9 are hereby incorporated into this Amendment and the Franchise Agreement by this reference. The Maximum Service Rates established in Exhibit 1 as of January 1, 2023 shall thereafter be adjusted as provided in the Franchise Agreement.
- 21. <u>Miscellaneous</u>. In the event of any conflict between the Franchise Agreement and this Amendment, this Amendment shall control. Unless otherwise expressly provided, all section references in this Amendment refer to sections of the Franchise Agreement.

SB 1383-Related Services

- 1. <u>Definitions</u>. Article 1 of the Franchise Agreement is hereby amended to add the following definitions:
 - 1.1. "Hauler Route" means the designated weekly itinerary or sequence of stops scheduled to be performed by one collection vehicle providing regularly scheduled Cart or Bin collection services for Garbage, Recyclable Material or Organic Waste within the Service Area.
 - 1.2. "Prohibited Container Contaminants" means any of the following:
 - 1.2.1. Non-Organic Waste placed in the Organic Waste Container;
 - 1.2.2. Organic Waste placed in the Garbage Container that is specifically identified under this Agreement for collection in the Organic Waste Container or the Recyclable Materials Container;
 - 1.2.3. Organic Waste placed in the Recyclable Materials Container that is specifically identified under this Agreement for collection in the Organic Waste Container.
 - 1.3. "Route Review" means a visual inspection of Carts and Bins along a Hauler Route for the purpose of identifying Prohibited Container Contaminants.
 - 1.4. "SB 1383 Regulations" means the Short-lived Climate Pollutants (SLCP): Organic Waste Reductions regulations adopted by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery ("CalRecycle") in 2020.
- 2. <u>Route Reviews</u>.
 - 2.1. General Requirement. At least once annually, beginning July 1, 2022, CONTRACTOR shall conduct a Route Review for each Hauler Route. For each Route Review of a Hauler Route, CONTRACTOR shall inspect a number of Containers equal to 2% of the number of customers on the Hauler Route (rounded down to the nearest whole number), or 25 Containers, whichever is less. Only one (1) Container per customer shall be counted towards the above threshold. For example, if a Garbage Hauler Route has 2,000 customers, CONTRACTOR would inspect one (1) Garbage Container each for 25 Garbage customers on that Hauler Route. CONTRACTOR may, but shall not be required to, inspect more than the above number of Containers. Each inspection shall involve observing the contents of the Container using any method deemed appropriate by CONTRACTOR, but shall not require CONTRACTOR to disturb the contents or open any bags. CONTRACTOR may select the Containers to be inspected at random, or (if mutually agreed with CITY) by any other method not prohibited under the SB 1383 Regulations. For the avoidance of doubt, CONTRACTOR shall not be required to annually inspect every Container on a Hauler Route.
 - 2.2. <u>Notice of Contamination</u>. If CONTRACTOR finds Prohibited Container Contaminants in a Container during a Route Review, CONTRACTOR shall notify the customer of the violation in writing. The written notice shall include information regarding the customer's

requirement to properly separate materials into the appropriate Containers. The notice may be left on the customer's Container, gate, or door at the time the violation is discovered, and/or be mailed, e-mailed, electronically messaged or delivered personally to the customer. CONTRACTOR may dispose of the contents of any Container found to contain Prohibited Container Contaminants.

- 3. Education & Outreach.
 - 3.1. At least once annually, beginning July 1, 2022, CONTRACTOR shall provide the following to all its Organic Waste customers under this Agreement:
 - 3.1.1. Information on the Organic Waste customer's requirements to properly separate materials in appropriate containers.
 - 3.1.2. Information on methods for: the prevention of Organic Waste generation, recycling Organic Waste on-site, sending Organic Waste to community composting, and any other local requirements regarding Organic Waste.
 - 3.1.3. Information regarding the methane reduction benefits of reducing the landfill disposal of Organic Waste, and the methods of Organic Waste recovery contemplated by this Agreement.
 - 3.1.4. Information regarding how to recover Organic Waste.
 - 3.1.5. Information related to the public health and safety and environmental impacts associated with the landfill disposal of Organic Waste.
 - 3.2. The above information will be provided, at a minimum, through print and/or electronic media, and may also be provided through workshops, meetings and/or on-site visits.
- 4. Reporting.
 - 4.1. Beginning July 1, 2022, CONTRACTOR shall provide the following information to CITY as part of CONTRACTOR's regularly scheduled quarterly and annual reports under this Agreement:
 - 4.1.1. For information provided by CONTRACTOR pursuant to Section 3 above:
 - (a) Copies of all such information (including flyers, brochures, newsletters, invoice messaging, website and social media postings, mass emails, and other mass electronic messages).
 - (b) The date the information was disseminated or the direct contact made. For website and social media postings, this shall be the date posted.
 - (c) To whom the information was disseminated or the direct contact made. For mass distributions such as mailings or bill inserts, CONTRACTOR may provide the type and number of accounts receiving the information, rather than listing each recipient individually.

- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision, CONTRACTOR shall not be required to track or provide copies of emails, texts, or other electronic communications with individual customers (e.g. if a CSR answers a customer question).
- 4.1.2. For Route Reviews:
 - (a) The date the review was conducted.
 - (b) The name and title of each person conducting the review.
 - (c) A description of each Hauler Route reviewed, including CONTRACTOR's route number.
 - (d) A list of the account names and addresses where Container inspections were performed.
 - (e) The results of such review (i.e. the addresses where any Prohibited Container Contaminants were found).
 - (f) Copies of any educational materials issued pursuant to such reviews (other than notices of Prohibited Container Contaminants, which are covered below).
- 4.1.3. The following documentation relating to Prohibited Container Contaminants observed during Route Reviews:
 - (a) Copies of the form of each notice issued by CONTRACTOR to customers for Prohibited Container Contaminants, as well as, for each such form, a list of the customers to which such notice was issued, the date of issuance, the customer's name and service address, and the reason for issuance (if the form is used for multiple reasons).
 - (b) The number of times notices were issued to customers for Prohibited Container Contaminants.
 - (c) The number of Containers where the contents were disposed due to observation of Prohibited Container Contaminants.
- 4.1.4. A description of CONTRACTOR's process for determining the level of Container contamination under this Agreement.
